Pretreatment Program Changes, Developments, and Updates

No program changes, developments, or updates were made during this reporting period concerning the local limits, monitoring program, legal authority, enforcement policy, or funding levels. Staffing changes included removing a mid-level manager position (Environmental Program Manager I) and adding an inspector (Environmental Specialist II).

While we continue to implement required activities related to inspection, sampling, and enforcement oversight of industrial users, we have procedures and processes in place to modify them as needed by business restrictions for COVID-19.

Renewal of all Significant Industrial User and Non-Significant Industrial User permits is in progress. Permit terms are usually 4-years. A majority of permits have been extended to December 31, 2022 while renewal is occurring during summer 2022, and terms will not exceed 5 years.

Compliance Status per most recent Pretreatment Compliance Audit/Inspection

A Pretreatment Compliance Audit (PCA) of the Regional San Pretreatment Program will be conducted on July 29, 2022.
